## DO GOOD!

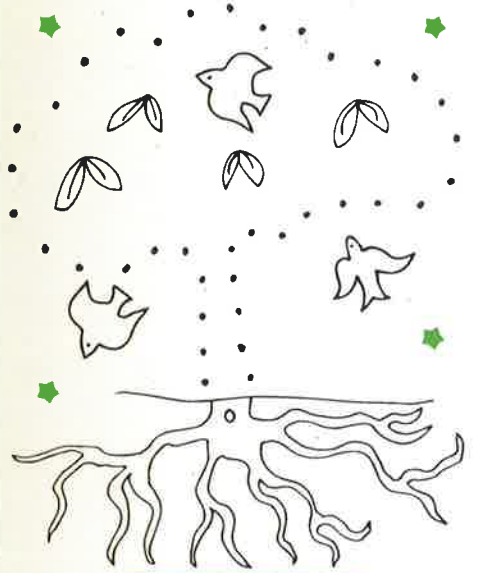
### Separating the weeds from the wheat

The kingdom of God is might have very small beginnings, but it can make amazing things happen!

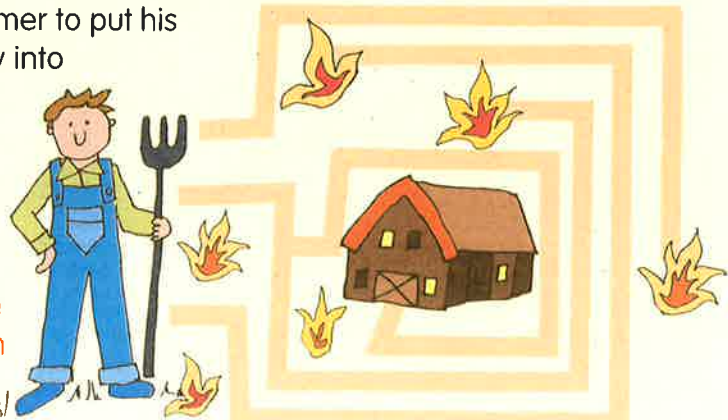


Match up the small item on the top with the big thing that it becomes.
