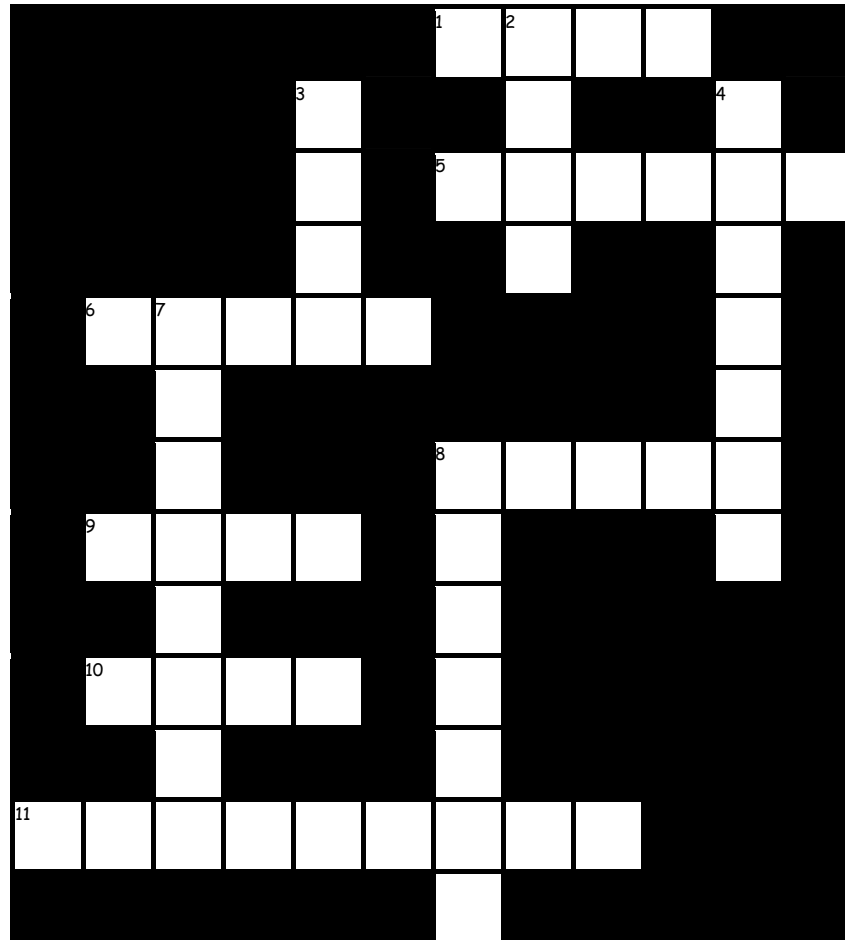


CROSSWORD

- 11: people who follow

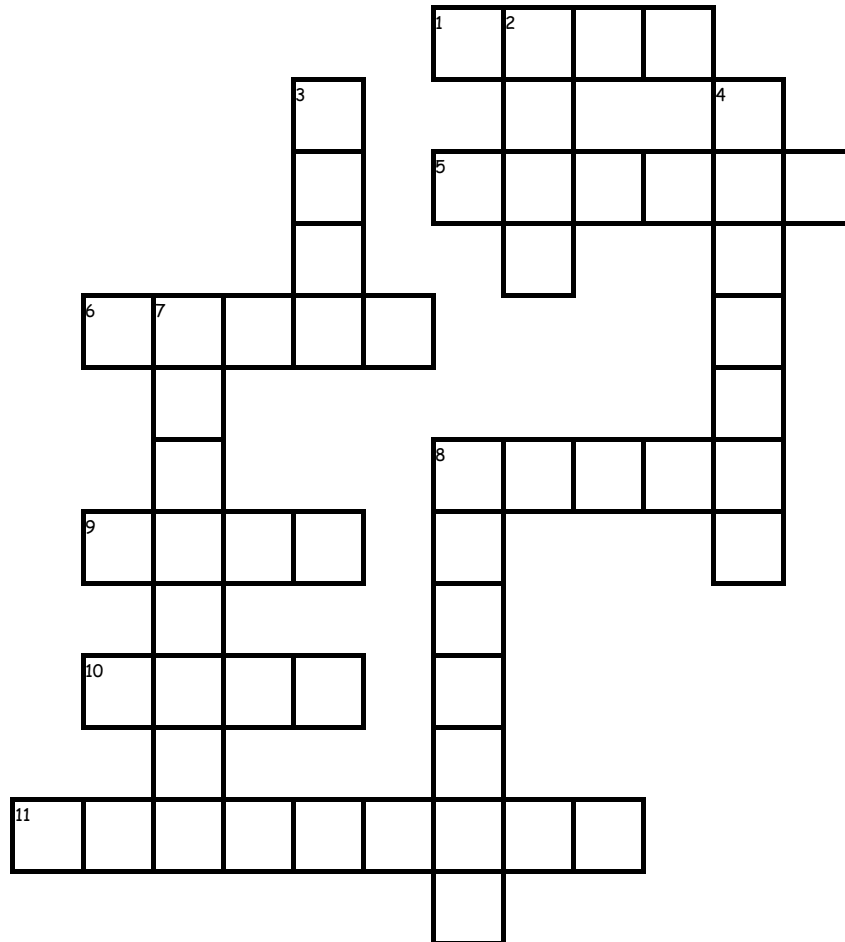
Down

- 8: the man owed the official this many silver coins

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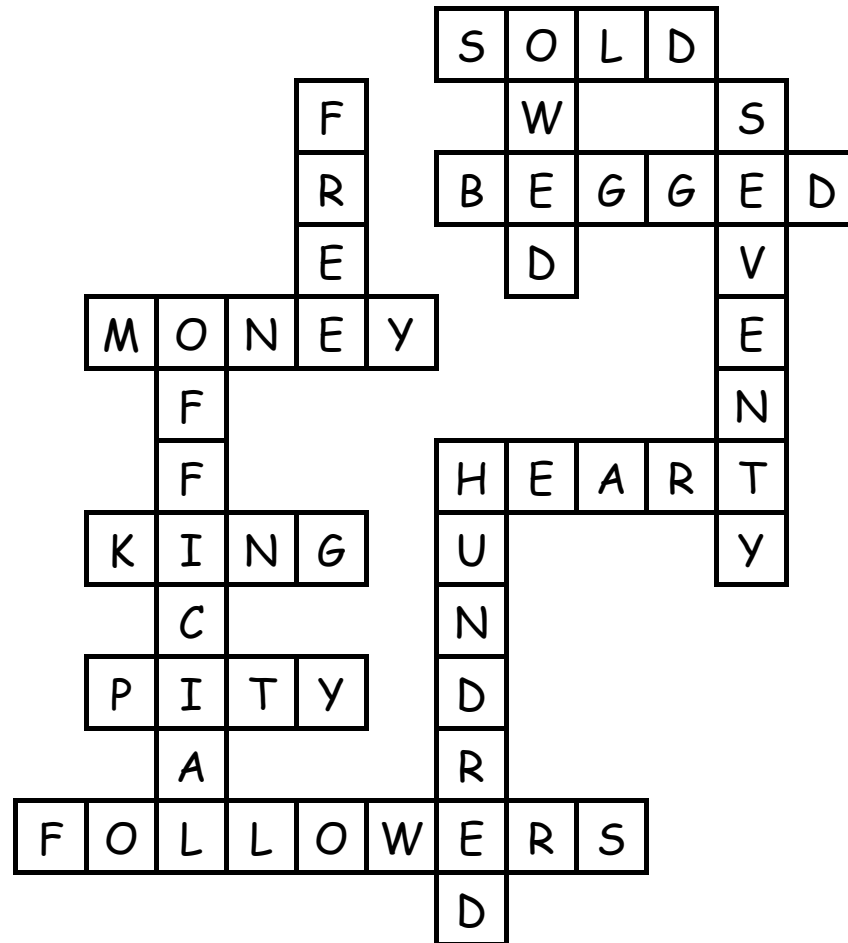
